MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 18(1) OF
THE STANDARDS ACT

THE COMPULSORY STANDARDS ORDER, 2020

1. This Order may be cited as the Compulsory Standards Order, Citation 2020.

2. On the recommendation of the Trinidad and Tobago Bureau of Standards, the following standards listed in the First Column of the Schedule with the corresponding title in the Second Column of the Schedule, which were notified in Legal Notices No. 321 of 2020 and No. 322 of 2020 respectively, are hereby declared compulsory standards for the purposes set out in the Third Column of the Schedule.

3. This Order comes into effect on the 4th day of January, 2021.

TTCS 4:2020	Rolled structural steel products— Bars, plates, shapes and sheet piling—Compulsory requirements	To protect the consumer or user against danger to health or safety and ensure acceptable quality in products for home use or export.
