THE COMPULSORY STANDARDS ORDER, 2024

1. This Order may be cited as the Compulsory Standards Order, Citation 2024.

2. On the recommendation of the Trinidad and Tobago Bureau of Standards, the following standards listed in the Schedule are hereby declared compulsory standards:
