On the recommendation of the Trinidad and Tobago Bureau of Compulsory Standards, the following standards listed in the First Column of the Standards Schedule with the corresponding titles in the Second Column of the declared Schedule, which were notified in Legal Notice No. 71 of 2021, are hereby declared compulsory standards for the purposes set out in the Third Column of the Schedule.

3. This Order comes into effect on the 7th day of June, 2021. Commencement
