ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 18(1) OF THE  
STANDARDS ACT, 1997

THE COMPULSORY STANDARDS ORDER, 2006

1. This Order may be cited as the Compulsory Standards Order, Citation 2006.

2. On the recommendation of the Bureau, the following standards, the declaration of which was notified in Legal Notice No. 3 of 2005, are declared compulsory standards:

<i>Trinidad and Tobago Standard</i>	<i>Title</i>
TTS 76: Part 15: 2005	Requirements for Labelling—Part 15: Labelling of General Household and Automotive Cleaning Chemical (1st Revision)
TTS 76: Part 18: 2005	Requirements for Labelling—Part 18: Labelling of Plywood

3. The purpose of the standards referred to as—
- (a) TTS 76: Part 15: 2005, is to protect the consumer or user against danger to health or safety and to prevent fraud or misrepresentation arising from misleading advertising or labelling; and
  - (b) TTS 76: Part 18: 2005, is to prevent fraud and misrepresentation arising from misleading advertising or labelling.

4. This Order comes into effect on the 31st day of July, 2006.
