- 2. On the recommendation of the Bureau, the following standards, Compulsory the declaration of which was notified in Legal Notice No. 3 of 2005, are standards declared compulsory standards:

3. The purpose of the standards referred to as—

Purpose of standards

(a) TTS 76: Part 15: 2005, is to protect the consumer or user against danger to health or safety and to prevent fraud or misrepresentation arising from misleading advertising or labelling; and

Labelling of Plywood

- (b) TTS 76: Part 18: 2005, is to prevent fraud and misrepresentation arising from misleading advertising or labelling.
- 4. This Order comes into effect on the 31st day of July, 2006.
