 - (c) TTS 179: 2005, is to prevent fraud or deception arising from misleading labelling and to protect the consumer or user against danger;

- (d) TTS 58: 2005, is to protect the consumer or user against danger to health and safety and to ensure acceptable quality of the product; and
- (e) TTS 587: 2005, is to protect the consumer or user against danger to human life and safety.
