MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 18(1) OF
THE STANDARDS ACT

THE COMPULSORY STANDARDS ORDER, 2023

1. This Order may be cited as the Compulsory Standards Order, Citation 2023.

2. On the recommendation of the Trinidad and Tobago Bureau of Standards, the following standards listed in the First Column of the Schedule with the corresponding titles in the Second Column of the Schedule, which were notified in Legal Notice No. 65 of 2022, are hereby declared compulsory standards for the purposes set out in the Third Column of the Schedule.

3. This Order comes into effect on 30th October, 2023.

TTCS 12-2:2022	Electric Cables— Thermosetting insulated, armoured cables of rated voltages of 600/1000 V and 1900/3300 V for fixed installations	To protect public or industrial health, welfare or safety. To ensure acceptable quality in products whether produced for home use or export.
