THE COMPULSORY STANDARDS ORDER, 2022

1. This Order may be cited as the Compulsory Standards Order, Citation 2022.

2. On the recommendation of the Trinidad and Tobago Bureau of Standards, the following standard is hereby declared a compulsory standard:
