0 FOREWORD

- 0.1 This code of practice was declared a Trinidad and Tobago Standard with effect from March 13, 1980 when the draft finalized by the Specifications Committee on Design and the Sectional Committee on Textiles, Garments and Shoes was approved by the Standards Council.
- 0.2 This standard was prepared to give directions to a growing industry, the manufacture of children's garments and gives advice on all aspects of the making of a garment.
- 0.3 In this standard the words, *child, infant, toddler* have the meanings normally associated with them in the English Language.
- 0.4 No attempt has been made to distinguish these stages chronologically because there is no strict correlation between age and physical development of the child.
