NOTICE OF DECLARATION OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO
STANDARDS

IN ACCORDANCE with section 16(4) of the Standards Act, No. 18 of 1997, the Trinidad and Tobago Bureau of Standards hereby gives notice that the following specifications were declared by the Bureau to be Trinidad and Tobago Standards with effect from 16th December, 2005. The Bureau also intends to recommend to the Honourable Minister that these standards be made compulsory sometime in the future.

TTS 76: Part 13: 2005	Requirements for labelling—Part 13: Labelling of domestic electrical appliances (1st Revision)	To prevent fraud or deception arising from misleading labelling and to protect the consumer or user against danger.
TTS 177: 2005	Tungsten filament lamps for general service—Specification (2nd Revision)	To protect the consumer or user against danger to health and safety.
TTS 179: 2005	Lead-acid starter batteries—Specification (2nd Revision)	To prevent fraud or deception arising from misleading labelling and to protect the consumer or user against danger.
TTS 58: 2005	Specification for liquid chlorine bleaches (2nd Revision)	To protect the consumer or user against danger to health and safety and to ensure acceptable quality of the product.
TTS 587: 2005	Hollow clay block—Vertical core—Specification	To protect the consumer or user against danger to human life and safety.
