INTENTION TO MAKE AN ORDER DECLARING
COMPULSORY STANDARDS

NOTICE is hereby given in accordance with section 18(2) of the Standards Act, Chap. 82:03, that the Minister of Trade and Industry, on the recommendation of the Trinidad and Tobago Bureau of Standards, intends to make an Order declaring the standards listed in the First Column of the Schedule with the corresponding titles listed in the Second Column of the Schedule as compulsory standards, with effect from the 30th day of October, 2023, for the purposes specified in the Third Column of the Schedule.

TTCS 12-1:2022	Flexible cords and cables	To protect public or industrial health, welfare or safety. To ensure acceptable quality in products whether produced for home use or export.
TTCS 12-2:2022	Electric Cables— Thermosetting insulated, armoured cables of rated voltages of 600/1000 V and 1900/3300 V for fixed installations	To protect public or industrial health, welfare or safety. To ensure acceptable quality in products whether produced for home use or export.
